Family Empowerment Services enhances the ability of families to provide for their children's well-being in a way that is non-intrusive and time limited.

- The family must live in Philadelphia with a child under the age of 18, who lives in the home. Services are provided to families without cost.
- Case managers for Family Empowerment Services act as advocates, educators, and resources for their families. The goal is to enhance the ability of the caregivers to provide for their children's safety and well-being.

The Crittenton Family Support Center provides prevention services and supports to families in Northwest and North Philadelphia. Services offered at this location are Family Empowerment Services (FES), Truancy Intervention and Prevention Services (TIPS), and Parent Education.
